She writes on a range of topics in different formats (curricula, training manuals, brochures, etc.) for diverse audiences.

Among other projects, Ms. King wrote and developed ToucanEd's awareness-level pandemic influenza course, which the California Office of Homeland Security approved as a training resource for a variety of audiences.



In addition, she has developed and written curricula, pamphlets, and trainings in the areas of infection prevention, hand hygiene, smoking cessation, health care access, sexual violence prevention, and nutrition.
